Walk-in Vaccinations

For week beginning 8 November, vaccinations are available at the following walk-in clinics to all aged 12 years and over for a first dose; to all aged 17 years and 9 months and over for a second dose; and to those eligible to receive a booster vaccination:

Vicars Cross Pharmacy, Green Lane, Chester CH3 5LB (Pfizer, Astra Zeneca and Moderna – including boosters)

- Monday 8 November 3pm to 5.30pm
- Tuesday 9 November 3pm to 5.30pm
- Wednesday 10 November 3pm to 5.30pm
- Thursday 11 November 3pm to 5.30pm

Hartford Methodist Church, Beach Road, Northwich CW8 3AB (Pfizer and Moderna – **including boosters**)

- Tuesday 9 November 9am to 6pm
- Wednesday 10 November 9am to 6pm
- Thursday 11 November 9am to 6pm

In addition, vaccinations are available at the following walk-in clinic to all aged 16 years and over for a first dose; and all aged 17 years and 9 months and over for a second dose. This clinic is not offering booster vaccinations except by pre-arranged appointment.

Tarvin Community Centre, Meadow Close, Tarvin CH3 8LY (Pfizer and Astra Zeneca – first and second dose only)

- Wednesday 10 November 9am to 4.30pm
- Thursday 11 November 9am to 5pm

The vaccines are available to all as a first dose and as a second dose to those who have already received one dose of the same vaccine, providing there is an eight-week gap between doses.

Appointments for primary course and booster vaccinations can also be pre-booked for alternative venues through the National Booking Service either online at: www.nhs.uk/covid-vaccination or by phoning 119.

Vaccinations for 12 -15-year-olds

These will continue in schools until mid-November but can also now be pre booked through the National Booking Service either online at: at: www.nhs.uk/covid-vaccination or by phoning 119. Vaccinations for this cohort are also available at walk-in sites as detailed above.

Booster Vaccinations

The phase three booster programme is available to anyone aged 50 and over. Boosters can only be given six months after the second dose vaccination and so initially, the focus is on those who received their vaccination at the start of the programme.

The phase three booster programme is being delivered through our Primary Care Network and Pharmacy sites and pop-up offer. Residents will be contacted directly by their GP or NHS England to make an appointment when their booster is due. Booster appointments can also be booked through the National Booking Service either online at: www.nhs.uk/covid-vaccination or by phoning 119.
